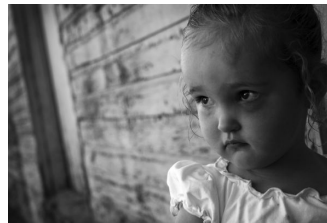

Conference aims: Conference aims: This one-day conference and workshop is directed at professionals working with children and families in Kingston, where neglect or abuse is involved. It is multidisciplinary in focus, involving social workers in child protection and family support; police and criminal justice workers; psychologists and psychiatrists in clinical and forensic fields working with children and adults; and paediatricians, health visitors etc. The aim of the day is to describe a research approaches to assessment of children and young people in social work, police and court practice contexts. A standardised measure of neglect/abuse is described research findings outlined and implications for practice explored. Case material used to trigger discussion about using the interview in different practice contexts and with different age groups.
